

FOOD PARCELS, PANTRIES AND VOUCHERS

These agencies provide food parcels, food pantries or vouchers to people in need in the City of Greater Geelong. Please contact agencies prior to visiting to ensure that you are eligible (most require a pension or healthcare card, others have geographical boundaries). Some agencies require you to pre-book an appointment and some limit as to how often you can access their services.
